- 1.1 The Championships shall be conducted under the Rules and By-laws of World Aquatics as prescribed in the Competition Regulations (Approved on 21 February 2023). One-start rule applies. The list of approved swimsuits can be viewed at <https://www.worldaquatics.com/swimming/approved-swimwear>
- 1.2 The Championships are open only to the following:
- Swimmers who are existing members of Singapore Aquatics Affiliates (thereafter known as Affiliates).
 - Members of other Federations affiliated to World Aquatics who meet the entry qualification standards (where applicable).
- 1.3 Definition of Swimmers:
- Local Swimmers- All Affiliated Members with a Valid Singapore NRIC or FIN#
 - Foreign Swimmers- All Swimmers without a Valid Singapore NRIC or FIN#

2.0 ENTRY REGULATIONS

2.1 AGE GROUPS

A swimmer may only compete in the stipulated age group in which he/she falls under.
Swimmers must be at least the age of 25 years (Born in year 1998 or earlier)

Age groups are computed as of follows:

2.2 Closing date for entries – Monday, 2nd October 2023, 12.00pm

Deadline for payment – Monday, 16th October 2023, 12.00pm

- a. Entries must be accompanied by full payment of the registration and entries fees. Swimmers **will not be eligible to compete** if the full payment does not reach Singapore Aquatics by the below deadline.
- b. There is no limit to the number of individual entries per swimmer.
- c. Swimmers participating in the relay events must be registered to at least one individual event.

2.2.1 **Swimmers Registration Fee** (For local and international swimmers)

The Singapore Masters 2023 registration fee is **S\$86.40 (inclusive of 8% GST)** per swimmer.

This fee is applicable to all swimmers.

2.2.2 **Entry Fee**

Individual Event - **S\$16.20 (inclusive of 8% GST)**

Relay Event - **S\$43.20 (inclusive of 8% GST)** per team/per event*

**Relay swimmers must all have one individual event each*

2.2.3 **Late Entries Charges:**

Late entries after the entries deadline can be accepted but at the cost of twice the entry fee per event inclusive of 8% GST

a. Individual Event - **\$32.40 (inclusive of 8% GST) per event**

b. Relay Event - **S\$86.40 (inclusive of 8% GST) per event**

This double charge will be in effect for entries that are submitted between **2nd October 2023. 1.00pm and 13th October 2023.**

2.2.4 Changes and corrections may be made up to the meet entry deadline without penalty.

Any changes, amendments, and corrections to the entries after the deadline of 2nd October 2023 may be made up till one day before the release of the psych sheet at a cost of **\$32.40** per change or correction (For example: a change in entry timing, switching events or removing a swimmer/event).

Deadline for Amendments – Friday 13th October 2023 10.00am.

Withdrawals of entered events can be done at no charge but entries fees will not be refunded.

2.3 Cheque and payment for all registration and entries are to be made payable to “**Singapore Swimming Association**” by latest **12.00pm on Friday, 13th October 2023.** If payment for the entry fee is not made on time, the entries **will not** be accepted.

3.0 COMPETITION INFORMATION

3.1 Events listed below will be for both Men and Women:

- a. Freestyle: 50m, 100m, 200m
- b. Backstroke: 50m and 100m
- c. Breaststroke: 50m and 100m
- d. Butterfly: 50m and 100m
- e. Individual Medley: 100m
- f. Freestyle Relays: 4 x 25m
- g. Medley Relay: 4 x 25m
- h. Mixed Medley Relay: 4 x 25m

3.2 Technical Officials – All Technical Officials shall be appointed by the Singapore Aquatics Technical Swimming Committee.

3.3 The Singapore Masters 2023 Committee reserves the right to the Singapore Aquatics' decision on all matters pertaining to the Championships.

3.4 Format of Competition – The Championships are run in the World Aquatics Short-Course Metres (SCM) format over three consecutive days.

The meet will be run in a timed finals format in a 10 lanes pool setup.

The meet will be run in a timed finals format in 10 Lanes Pool setup from slowest to fastest. Competitors (regardless of age) shall be placed in graduated time order.

5.0 ACCREDITATIONS

- 5.1 Accreditation will be given to each swimmer. If there are coaches for the group, they will have to write in to get approval for a coach and list who they are coaching in the competition.

Starting from 1 July 2018, coaches who wish to apply for an accreditation pass to be on deck during national competitions must be an NROC Member.

Clubs / Schools are required to send in the names of their coaches and team managers with their entry files to secure a pass.

Please note that the pool deck at all Singapore Aquatics national competitions is strictly reserved for registered athletes, coaches, essential support staff, event staff or other persons approved by Singapore Aquatics.

All accreditation cards remain the property of Singapore Aquatics, are NON-TRANSFERABLE, and can be withdrawn or refused at Singapore Aquatics's sole discretion.

Please note that applying for an accreditation under false pretences would be a violation of accreditation procedures. In order to ensure a safe and inclusive training and competition environment, we would ask that rules and regulations surrounding accreditation be respected.

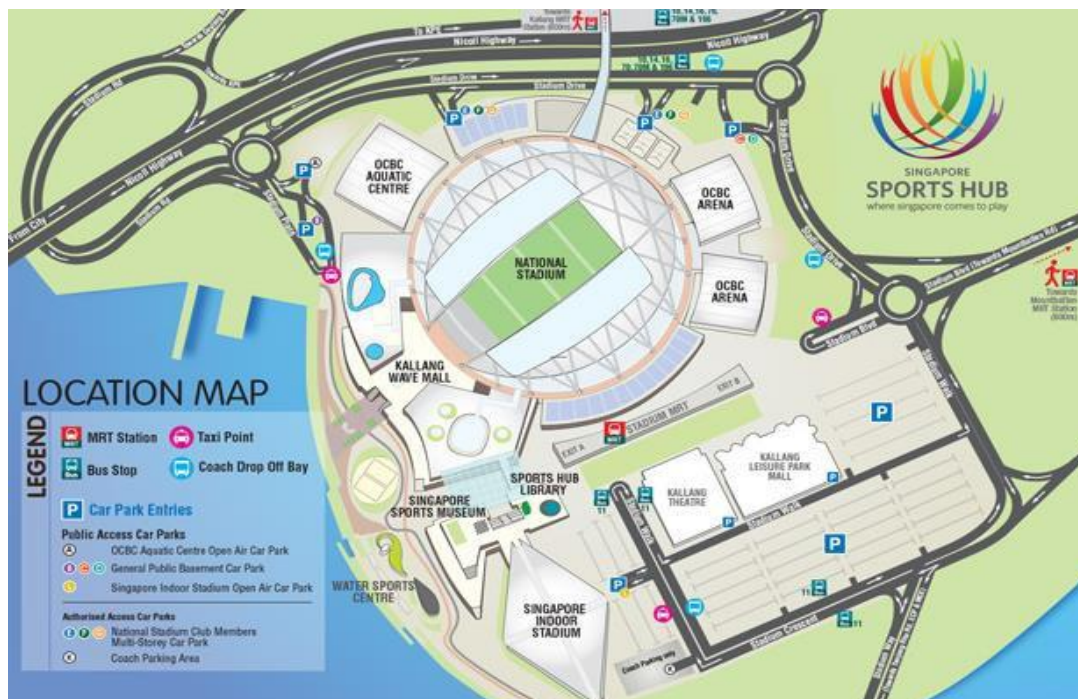
Anyone found to be in violation of this will have their accreditation removed and will be asked to leave the venue immediately.

6.0 COMPETITION VENUE

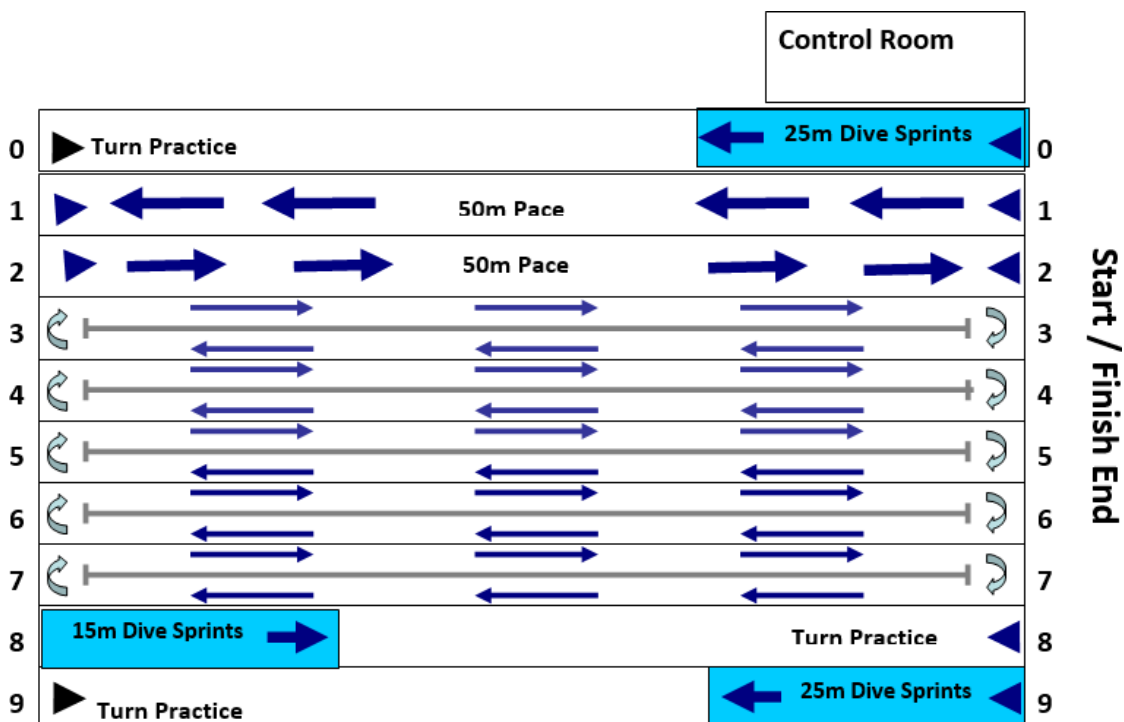

Venue Management does not allow any foldable chairs/beds into the OCBC Aquatic Centre due to the Fire Safety Regulation.

7.0 WARM-UP GUIDELINES

- 7.1 The Competition and Warm-Up Pools will be available for warm-ups one and the half hour before the competitions commence. The Competition Pool will be closed fifteen (15) minutes before the beginning of each session.
- 7.2.1 Lane assignments for warm-ups will be in accordance with World Aquatics Swimming Rules



- 7.3 Competition Pool
- a. The schematic in the diagram shall be observed at all times during warm-ups.

There shall be **NO DIVING** in the Circle Swimming Lanes, the Turn Practice Lanes, and the 50m Pace Lane (opposite side). Entry to these lanes is via feet first entry from the sitting position at all times.

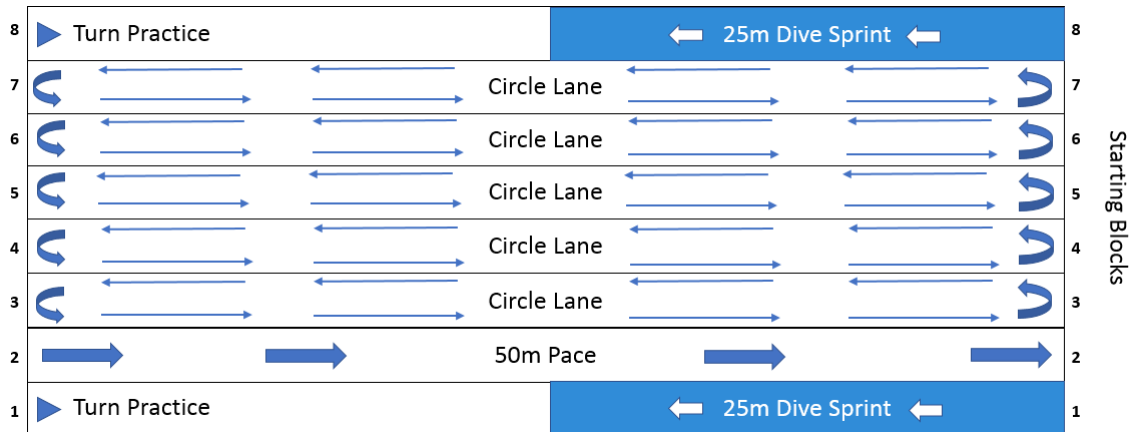
The Dive Sprint Lanes are one-way only – swimmers should clear the lanes immediately and walk back. Swimmers are advised to exercise caution when doing Backstroke starts.

Coaches and Team Officials will be allowed on the Competition Pool Deck during the warm-up sessions.

In order to ensure a smooth Swimming Competition Time-Lines Compliance and to eliminate downtime due to infraction enquiry to the Referee, promote Fair Play during the Swimming Competition and Technical Officials duty obstruction, the Pool Deck is strictly out of bound to ALL

except the Technical Officials on duty, Swimming Competition Management Committee, Appointed Volunteer, Appointed Media Coverage Personnel.

7.4 Training Pool Guideline



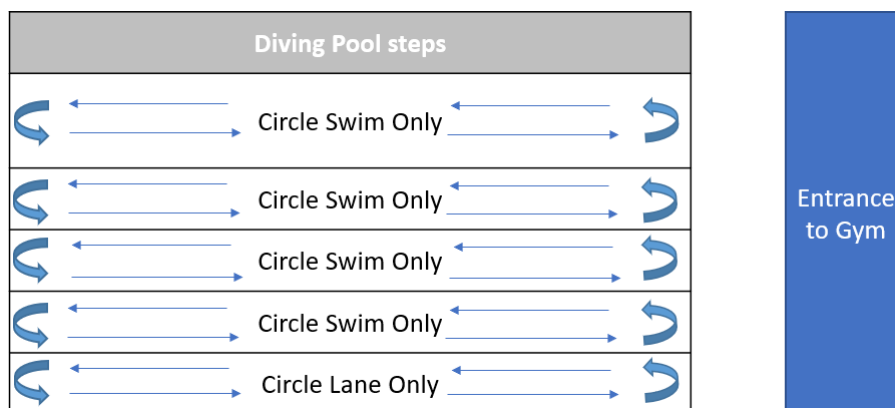
7.4.1 Diving Pool Guideline

The diving pool and its surrounding areas are on a first-come-first serve basis.

The diving pool is an additional space for swimmers to warm up & down and will be a **circle swimming lane only at all times**.

Should swimmers decide to swim backstroke, they are to exercise caution to not hit other swimmers or the wall as there are no backstroke flags.

Strictly no plunging/diving in all lanes in lieu of the safety of all swimmers



8.0 CONTROL ROOM GUIDELINES (Infraction Enquiry or Clarification)

- a. Request for the details of Infraction committed by the swimmer or swimmers shall be made to the Swimming Competition Meet Director by the Team Leader. No proxies will be entertained.
- b. In the absence of Meet Director, the infraction enquiry shall be directed only to the Deputy Meet Director or Control Room Supervisor.
- c. Enquiry of infraction shall be made within the same day of competition.
- d. Team Leader shall provide Swimmer Details i.e. Event Number, Heat Number, Swimmer's Name, Affiliate Name and Lane assigned,
- e. ONLY the Team Leader shall be allowed access to Swimming Competition Control Room to retrieve finals result print-outs, submission of paperwork and Infraction Enquiry. No proxies shall be allowed.

9.0 PROTESTS

- 9.1 Protests are possible:
- if the rules and regulations for the conduct of the competition are not observed,
 - if other conditions endanger the competitions and/or competitors, or
 - against decisions of the referee;
 - however, no protest shall be allowed against decisions of fact.
- 9.2 All protests shall be considered by the Meet Referee. However, protests against decisions of fact shall not be allowed.
- 9.3 If conditions causing a potential protest are noted prior to the competition, a protest must be lodged before the signal to start the race is given.
- 9.4 Protests must be submitted in accordance with the following:
- In writing, with the supporting facts.
 - With a deposit of **S\$108.00** enclosed.
 - Submitted to the Meet Referee by Affiliate Team Leader. No proxies will be entertained.
 - Submitted within thirty (30) minutes following the conclusion of the respective event.
- 9.5 If the Meet Referee rejects the protest, he/she must state the reasons for his decision. The Team Leader may then appeal the rejection to the Jury of Appeal, whose decision shall be final.
- 9.6 If the protest is rejected, the deposit shall be forfeited to the Organising Committee of the competition. If the protest is upheld, the deposit shall be returned.
