Competition Format:

There will not be any call room. Swimmers are to report to their lane’s start blocks at least 15 minutes before the start of their event.

Swimmers who participated at the 2023 SEA Games and 2022 Junior Pan Pacs are not allowed to race at the SSPA Event

Registration

2023 Annual Registration Fees

Starting from 2022, all swimmers (*regardless of whether they belong to an affiliate club*) who participate in SAQ organised SSPAs must pay the 2023 Annual Registration Fee which will be S\$43.20 (inclusive of 8% GST) per swimmer. For those who have paid in previous SAQ organised or sanctioned meets in the earlier part of 2023, this payment is not required.

Individual Event Fees

Each event costs \$16.20 (inclusive of 8% GST).
Events must have at least 4 participants to commence.

Late entries* will cost \$32.40 (inclusive of 8% GST).
**(Any entries submitted after 16th October 2023, 12noon)*

For affiliate clubs & international schools an invoice will be issued.

For individuals, a PDF Invoice will be sent to you for payment separately. You will be able to make payment via PayNow QR code, please do state your invoice number when making payment.

Registration

Registrations must be submitted by 16th October 2023, 12 noon.

- Please do provide an entry time to aid in providing a better estimate of the competition day's schedule & flow of events.

Late Individual Event Entry Fees

- Any entries submitted after the 16th of October 2023; 12 noon will be subject to a late entry fee of \$32.40 (inclusive of 8% GST). Late entries will only be accepted till 20th October 2023.
- Once the start list is out on 23rd October 2023, no more entries will be accepted and added.

Certificates

Certificates will be awarded to each swimmer if they have swum a timing that is faster or equal to the passing time and did not get disqualified.

Certificates can be collected by the club/school team administrator/coach at the end of the SSPA. Club administrators/coaches please do email in to let Singapore Aquatics know the preferred collection process.

If the swimmer does not belong to a club/is participating individually/the club is not collecting for the swimmers, they can opt to collect the certificate after the end of their event at the competition venue.
