



In the sport of swimming, the Technical Officials play a significant role in ensuring fair play and that all meets have a levelled playing field, which allows for the best race experience for all swimmers.

After undergoing the course, trainees will be able to officiate in the following roles:

- Timekeeper
- Inspector of turns
- Clerk of course
- Chief inspector of Turns
- Chief Timekeeper

Course Requirements

Participants must be at least 18 years old and should not be older than 65 years old as of 31st December 2024 to be eligible for this course.

For the course to proceed, there must be a minimum of 10 pax registered.

The course has a maximum capacity of 25 pax.

The registration limit will be determined by the time each person registers via the google form. Once the number of participants has reached 25 or on Wednesday 10am (whichever comes first), the registration will close.

Registration Process & Fees

Registration will close on the 7th of February 2024 or when the maximum number of participants has been reached.

The course will be \$120 (before GST) and is not a course under the SkillsFuture scheme. Payment details will be given upon confirmation of the applicant's successful registration.

Payment must be made within 3 days of receiving the confirmation. Failure to do so will result in the slot being given to the next person in the registration waiting list.

Course Passing Criteria

Participants must attend all 3 sessions to be eligible for the final assessment.

Participants are required to attain at least 75% in the theory assessment and pass the practical assessment. Failure in any of the assessment will result in the participant being unable to complete the course.
