Note: Electronic keypads will not be used for this event. Judges will use flash cards instead.

Competition Rules

- If a diver enters an event in a particular level, they are only permitted to enter events from that level. Exception is for Open events; divers may enter both an Age-Group and Open event.
- Dives of the same number may not be repeated for all events and levels
- Only for Primary (Junior/Senior) events, and Secondary/Tertiary Level 1 to 3 events, dives may be performed with either a standing, hurdle, one bounce, two bounce or three bounce take-off.
- Please note for the event Level 1: Jumps may enter the water with arms up or arms down with no penalty.
- Dives must be competed in the order presented in the table.
- It is the coach's responsibility to enter their divers into the correct level. Divers deemed to be performing at an incorrect level will be notified by SAQ staff.

Sequence

- Pool warm-up: 20-40mins (depending on event)
- Boards close 10 min before event start time
- Divers to report to marshal at banner for athlete parade
 - Listen to announcement call!
 - At least 5 min before event start time
 - Athlete parade – be dressed in school tracksuit / shorts & t-shirt
- Event starts immediately after athlete parade – first few divers must be ready at the boards
 - Divers are expected to be ready at the board when it is their turn, otherwise disqualified
- Medal ceremony at the end of each session
 - Medalists to report to marshal at tentage at end of second last round
 - Listen to announcement call!

Warm-up

- Areas for dryland warm up:
 - Poolside
 - Gym
 - Dry dive room
- Priority to be given to divers competing in the immediate next event
- Divers on different boards are permitted to warm up at the same time
 - e.g. next event is 1m or 3m, PF divers are permitted to warm-up
- Dry dive room – only permissible for divers competing at Level 3 or higher
 - i.e. out of bounds for competing divers in Level 1 and Level 2

Awards

- All participants will receive an e-certificate – strongly encourage divers to share with their school
- Medals given to top 3 male and female athletes in each event per age group (only secondary and tertiary categories are combined if 3 or less divers in either group)
- Guest divers will also receive medals if in top 3 position, however their ranking will not count towards the overall student divers
- Medal ceremony will be held at the end of each session (once before lunch break, once at end of day)
- Results will be posted by the poolside and electronic version will be uploaded to SAQ google drive after each day
- Medal winners to be ready before the end of last event (dress in school tracksuits if applicable)

Logistic Matters

- Divers, coaches, officials to enter via OCBC Aquatic Centre Athlete Entrance
 - Accreditation pass needed for entry
 - Multiple entry allowed
- Accreditation passes must be worn at all times
 - Fees chargeable for replacement of lost or damaged accreditation pass
- Non-accredited personnel are not allowed into the warm-up areas and competition areas
- Spectators are allowed – entry fees payable for spectators each time
- No refund of entry fees in the event of any cancellation
