Costs incurred from any travel deviations will have to be borne by the athlete. Age Criteria	<p>This is an Age Classification Meet: (Age as of 31 Dec 2024) As per Pan Pacific Charter  Competition Rules</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The competition is restricted to athletes who are 13 to 18 years. Age will be determined as of the 31st of December.</li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>For 2024, athletes born in 2006, 2007, 2008, 2009, 2010 and 2011 will be eligible.</li> </ul>
Pan Pac Eligibility	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>All non-LEN (non-European) nations will be invited to the meet.</li> <li>All athletes (from all nations) that competed in the Olympic Games, long course World Championships and/or the Pan Pacific Championships (either individually or on a relay) will NOT be permitted to swim at the Junior Pan Pacific Championships in that same calendar year.</li> <li>An athlete who competes at the World Aquatic Championships in the Open Water events can compete in the Junior Pan Pacific Pool Championships in the same year of competition.</li> </ul>
SAQ Eligibility	<p>To be considered for selection, a swimmer must meet ALL the following eligibility criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Be a Singapore citizen, eligible to represent Singapore.</li> <li>Be a registered member of SAQ in good standing.</li> <li>Have a signed current SAQ Athlete Agreement.</li> <li>Have competed in an above qualification meet unless granted an exemption under the provisions of the criteria by the SAQ Selection committee. This exemption will only be granted due to extenuating circumstances. On request of SAQ, evidence shall be provided of the extenuating circumstances, prior to the exemption being considered. Extenuating circumstances can include but is not limited to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Injury or Illness</li> <li>b. Equipment Failure</li> <li>c. Travel Delays</li> <li>d. Bereavement</li> <li>e. Such other circumstances as the selectors may consider to be relevant.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Continues to train for, behave and act towards peak swimming performance.</li> <li>Be available to fulfil the Team Commitments as listed below and any additional commitments following selection, as allowed by the permanent geographical training location.</li> <li>Not used or administered any substance which, if it had been detected as being present in the athlete’s body tissue or fluids, would have constituted doping, or used any prohibited method or committed any other doping offence as defined in ADS’s, WADA or WA’s Anti-Doping By-law.</li> </ul>
Team Commitments	<p>All swimmers and officials must:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Comply with the provisions of the SAQ Athletes/Officials Agreement at all times.</li> <li>Conform to SAQ requirements regarding team participation. This includes, but may not be limited to, providing an acceptable training plan, attendance at a pre-event camp and wearing team uniform as required. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Make themselves available for all team activities designated by SAQ.</li> <li>b. Pre-travel Briefing session (Dates TBD)</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Not act in such a manner as to bring the athlete or SAQ into public disrepute.</li> <li>• All swimmers and officials are required to appear at events and platforms whereby their images and presence are used to achieve SAQ’s objectives.</li> </ul>
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<p>Performance Requirements</p>	<p>To be <b>considered</b> for selection for individual events for the 2024 Junior Pan Pacific Championships, swimmers are required to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Achieve the minimum time standard for the meet.             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Table 1 – Wildcard Standards</li> </ul> </li> <li>• SAQ will consider a team of up to 40 swimmers across all age groups, gender and events.</li> <li>• ALL Times achieved from Heats and Finals in the designated selection meet (and OSB designated meets) are eligible for selection.             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Times from individual time-trials are <b>NOT</b> eligible for selection purposes.</li> <li>b. Times accomplished as a split of an individual event will <b>NOT</b> be used as qualifying times.</li> <li>c. Relay Lead offs and split times from relays will <b>NOT</b> be considered for the selection of individual events.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Times from the selection meet will be collated and a depth chart created to determine performance rank of swimmers per event and gender.</li> <li>• The top 2 spots per event in each event and gender will be selected for further consideration.             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. 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	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>d. Should a swimmer decline invitation the next ranked swimmer by FP will be invited.</li> <li>e. If spaces are available after selection based on top 2 per event and gender, the next ranked swimmer will be selected based on highest FP until all places are filled or there are no more eligible swimmers.</li> <li>f. SAQ shall not be obligated to take a full team of two athletes per event should a qualifying athlete not be available.</li> <li>g. The selection of athletes that have met all the eligibility and Performance Requirements will be announced on July 4, 2024.</li> </ul> <p>Criteria for Selection for Relay Events:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Selections for relays will be done from within the total team selected for the 2024 Junior Pan Pacific Championships.</li> <li>• SAQ philosophy is to ensure that the best possible relay team is on the blocks representing Singapore at the Championship meet. The final composition of the team will be determined by the coaching and management staff at the competition.</li> </ul>
<p>Coaches Selection</p>	<p>SAQ will nominate the Head Coach for the 2024 Junior Pan Pacific Swimming Championship. The Head Coach is selected based on previous experience and demonstrated capacity whilst representing Team SGP at Major Games and/or SAQ appointed international team staff.</p> <p>The number of assistant coaches will depend on the number of swimmers selected. Based on the ratio of 1 coach to 6 swimmers with a max of 2 coaches per club.</p> <p>Coaches must be registered as NROC and CoachSAQ members to be selected.</p> <p>The coaches will be selected in accordance of the following priority.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Nominated Coach (Coach of record) based on the number of swimmers on the team.</li> <li>2. Nominated Club Coach based on the number of swimmers on the team</li> </ol> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The National Head Coach will have the discretion to add coaches to the team</li> <li>• All selected coaches will be given the opportunity to have leadership positions for purposes of this meet based on previous experience and demonstrated capacity whilst representing with National and SAQ appointed Games and Camp staff.</li> </ul>
<p>Competition Fees</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The individual fees for the 2024 Junior Pan Pacific Swimming Championship shall be as follows.             <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. This is a SELF-FUNDED meet. However, swimmers who achieve the respective Funding Eligibility Cuts will be funded for this competition according to the Tiers that they qualify for, up to the total budget allocation for this meet*. Eligible swimmers will be broken into three funding tiers:                 <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>i. Tier 1 – Fully Funded</li> <li>ii. Tier 2 – Co Funding (50% of Competition Costs)</li> <li>iii. Tier 3 – Self Funded</li> </ol> </li> </ol> </li> </ul>

	<p>b. Funding Eligibility Cuts (A, B, C) determine the cost swimmers are responsible for (See Table 1)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>i. Tier 1 requirements – Achieve A/A or A/B cut combination in prelims and finals. Swimmers not achieving this requirement will drop to Tier 2.</li> <li>ii. Tier 2 requirements – Achieve A/C, B/B, B/C, C/C cut combination in prelims and finals. Swimmers not achieving this requirement will drop to Tier 3.</li> <li>iii. Tier 3 requirements – be invited with a minimum wildcard cut.</li> <li>iv. Swimmers in these tiers are ranked by FP and will receive funding based on the ranking and availability of funding.</li> </ul> <p>c. SAQ will cover the cost of coaches selected to the team.  d. SAQ will cover meet entry fees for all swimmers.  e. SAQ will provide team uniform / kit for all swimmers</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• To accept the invitation to join the team, swimmers are required to make payment for the trip along with their completed athlete agreement co-signed by a parent or guardian by the 5<sup>th</sup> July, 2024.</li> <li>• A package of information including associated costs will be posted to SAQ Website as soon as details are received from the host.</li> </ul> <p>Costs based on return flights from Singapore.  Group A – Junior Carded swimmers can elect this meet as their international racing option.  *SAQ allocates specific funding through ANGE / SPEX budgets annually. If more athletes qualify for funding than budget available, allocation of funds will be adjusted accordingly.</p>
Notes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Singapore Aquatics may amend these selection criteria at any time in its sole discretion by giving adequate notice to those swimmers who meet the eligibility criteria.</li> <li>• If a swimmer is unable to satisfy SAQ requirements after selection and needs to withdraw from the team, SAQ may at their discretion select the next swimmer who has met all the eligibility and performance requirements.
