Policy Objective	<p>To select divers that have the potential to succeed when representing Singapore at the event or future events.</p> <p>To select divers of a suitable standard to maintain Singapore Diving’s reputation at the Southeast Asian level.</p>
Qualifying Period	Qualification score must be achieved at the 14 th Singapore National Diving Championships 2024 (30 Aug – 01 Sep 2024)
Initial Release Date	10 th July 2024

Selection Meets	14 th Singapore National Diving Championships 2024 (30 Aug – 01 Sep 2024)
Key Deadlines	Key deadlines will be set upon release of the event information bulletin.
Events & Quota	SAQ intends to select the maximum number of qualified athletes allowed as per the information bulletin. Details will be released upon release of the information bulletin.
Eligibility	<p>A diver must meet all the following eligibility criteria and maintain through the competition:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Be a Singapore Citizen. 2. Meet the minimum age requirements as stipulated in the information bulletin (<i>pending release</i>). 3. Be a registered member of Singapore Aquatics (SAQ) in good standing. 4. Not used or administered any substance which, if it had been detected as being present in the athlete’s body tissue or fluids, would have constituted doping, or used any prohibited method or committed any other doping offence as defined in ADS, WADA or AQUA’s Anti-Doping By-law. 5. In addition to the qualifying criteria below, the following qualities of the divers will be taken into consideration: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Attitude and behaviour; b. General conduct and past disciplinary record; c. Current skill level and fitness; and character; d. Level of commitment and training attendance at minimum 80%; e. Potential for future development; f. Ability to demonstrate team spirit and work well with teammates and officials 6. Continues to train regularly for peak diving performance and be fit for competition for at least 3 months leading up to the competition.

Qualifying Criteria	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Divers who are members of the Singapore Aquatics (SAQ) National Training Squads (NTS) at the date of the selection meet will automatically qualify if the event conditions can be met. 2. If the number of eligible athletes per event exceeds the event quota, ranking from the 14th Singapore National Diving Championships 2024 will be used to select the divers. 3. Divers' who are not a member of SAQ NTS must achieve the sixth-place score from the 45th SEA Age Group Championships 2023 (SEA Age). The score must be achieved at the 14th Singapore National Diving Championships 2024 (30 Aug – 01 Sep 2024), in an event with equivalent conditions. 4. If there are six or less divers participating in an event at SEA Age, the third-place score must be achieved at (SISDC). 5. Divers wishing to compete in the open events who are not a member of SAQ NTS must achieve the minimum scores presented in Annex A. 6. Divers' must qualify through meeting the individual score for the event. Synchro teams will be selected from the divers who qualify through individual events. 7. If the total number of divers who qualify exceeds the maximum team quota, the Selection Committee will select the final team. 8. If a diver achieves qualification score in a single event, whether the diver can compete in additional events will be at the final discretion of the Selection Committee.
Team Commitments	<p>All divers must:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Sign the current SAQ Athlete's Agreement and comply with the provisions of the Agreement at all times. 2. Conform to SAQ requirements regarding team participation. This includes, but may not be limited to, providing an acceptable training plan, attendance at a pre-event camp and wearing team uniform as required. 3. Make themselves available for all team activities designated by SAQ. 4. The athlete should be a role model and not act in such a manner as to bring the athlete or SAQ into public disrepute. 5. Divers and officials are required to appear at events and platforms whereby their images and presence are needed to achieve SAQ's objectives of giving back to the Sport and the wider community. These obligations will be further outlined in the SAQ Athlete's Agreement as per Point 1

	<p>6. Participation in this event will be self-funded. Performance Awards will be awarded based on competition performance. Maximum of one Performance Award per athlete:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Gold medal = 30% of trip cost b. Silver/bronze medal = 15% of trip cost <p>7. SAQ reserves the right to withdraw a diver at any time who does not fulfil the requirements laid out in this document.</p>
<p>Appeal Process</p>	<p>Any diver who is aggrieved with his non-selection may undertake an appeal as follows:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The diver must contact the Vice President (Diving) in writing, within 48 hours from the announcement of the selection results and inform of the intent to appeal. 2. The Vice President may ask the diver to outline the basis of his appeal and will seek a report from the National Head Coach, within 24 hours of receiving written notification from the diver. 3. If the appeal committee is of the opinion that the selection process was not adhered to and the appeal is justified, the committee can overturn the decision of the selection committee. The appeals committee decision is final. <p><i>Note: Protests against the scores given by the judges during the competition or trials conducted, as part of the appeal, shall not be considered.</i></p>
