<b>Selection Meets</b>	To be eligible for selection, qualification score AND minimum DD must be achieved at one of the following events: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Fukuoka 2023 World Aquatics Championships (14-30 Jul 2023)</li> <li>• 2023 World University Games (08-19 Aug 2023)</li> <li>• 13<sup>th</sup> Singapore National Diving Championships 2023 (01-3 Sep 2023)</li> <li>• 19<sup>th</sup> Asian Games Hangzhou 2022 (23 Sep – 08 Oct 2023)</li> <li>• 1<sup>st</sup> Malaysia Open Diving Championships 2023 (04-06 Nov 2023)</li> <li>• 1<sup>st</sup> Madrid International Diving Meet 2023 (01-03 Dec 2023)</li> <li>• Doha 2024 World Aquatics Championships (02-18 Feb 2024)</li> <li>• 59<sup>th</sup> Malaysia Invitational Age Group Diving Championships (03-05 May 2024)</li> <li>• 14<sup>th</sup> Singapore National Diving Championships 2024 (30 Aug – 01 Sep 2024)</li> </ul>
<b>Key Deadlines</b>	Final Entry Form: 11 <sup>th</sup> October. Deadline for declining participation: 48 hours from communication of team selection.
<b>Events &amp; Quota</b>	SAQ intends to select the maximum number of qualified athletes allowed as per the information bulletin.
<b>Eligibility</b>	A diver must meet all the following eligibility criteria and maintain through the competition: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Be a Singapore Citizen.</li> <li>2. Meet the minimum age requirements as stipulated in the information bulletin.</li> <li>3. Be a registered member of Singapore Aquatics (SAQ) in good standing.</li> <li>4. Not used or administered any substance which, if it had been detected as being present in the athlete's body tissue or fluids, would have constituted doping, or used any prohibited method or committed any other doping offence as defined in ADS, WADA or AQUA's Anti-Doping By-law.</li> <li>5. In addition to the qualifying criteria below, the following qualities of the divers will be taken into consideration: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Attitude and behaviour;</li> <li>b. General conduct and past disciplinary record;</li> <li>c. Current skill level and fitness; and character;</li> <li>d. Level of commitment and training attendance at minimum 80%;</li> <li>e. Potential for future development;</li> </ol> </li> </ol>

	<p>f. Ability to demonstrate team spirit and work well with teammates and officials</p> <p>6. Continues to train regularly for peak diving performance and be fit for competition for at least 3 months leading up to the competition.</p>
<p><b>Qualifying Criteria</b></p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Divers must perform a dive list with a minimum degree of difficulty (DD) AND attain a minimum qualifying score at any of the approved selection meets. See Annex A.</li> <li>2. The minimum DD and qualifying score must be achieved in the same event.</li> <li>3. For platform events, qualifying score must be achieved with a list completed from 10m platform.</li> <li>4. Where 3 or more divers / 2 or more pairs meet the qualifying criteria during the qualifying period, the highest ranked athletes at the 14<sup>th</sup> Singapore National Diving Championships 2024 will be selected.</li> <li>5. Any selected diver who declines participation in the meet must inform the Sport Manager (Diving) in writing within 48 hours from the announcement of the selection results.</li> <li>6. The National Head Coach and the Selection Committee reserve the right to make the final decision to determine the final entry by name list.</li> </ol>
<p><b>Team Commitments</b></p>	<p>All divers must:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Sign the current SAQ Athlete’s Agreement and comply with the provisions of the Agreement at all times.</li> <li>2. Conform to SAQ requirements regarding team participation. This includes, but may not be limited to, providing an acceptable training plan, attendance at a pre-event camp and wearing team uniform as required.</li> <li>3. Make themselves available for all team activities designated by SAQ.</li> <li>4. The athlete should be a role model and not act in such a manner as to bring the athlete or SAQ into public disrepute.</li> <li>5. Divers and officials are required to appear at events and platforms whereby their images and presence are needed to achieve SAQ’s objectives of giving back to the Sport and the wider community. These obligations will be further outlined in the SAQ Athlete’s Agreement as per Point 1.</li> <li>6. Participation in this event will be funded as per the Athlete Funding Matrix presented in Annex B.</li> <li>7. SAQ reserves the right to withdraw a diver anytime who does not fulfil the requirements laid out in this document.</li> </ol>

<b>Appeal Process</b>	<p>Any diver who is aggrieved with his non-selection may undertake an appeal as follows:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The diver must contact the Vice President (Diving) in writing, within 48 hours from the announcement of the selection results and inform of the intent to appeal.</li> <li>2. The Vice President may ask the diver to outline the basis of his appeal and will seek a report from the National Head Coach, within 24 hours of receiving written notification from the diver.</li> <li>3. If the appeal committee is of the opinion that the selection process was not adhered to and the appeal is justified, the committee can overturn the decision of the selection committee. The appeals committee decision is final.</li> </ol> <p><i>Note: Protests against the scores given by the judges during the competition or trials conducted, as part of the appeal, shall not be considered.</i></p>
