

Competition	2025 World Aquatics Championships Singapore, Singapore 26 July – 03 August 2025
Policy Objective	To select the team of athletes to represent Singapore at the 2025 World Aquatics Championships in diving. The team of athletes should maximise the quota spots available, whilst maintaining Singapore Diving’s reputations at the world level.
Qualifying Period	24 th October 2024 – Sport Entries Deadline (Date TBC)
Initial Release Date	18 th October 2024

Selection Events	To be eligible for selection, qualification score AND minimum DD must be achieved at one of the following events: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 11th Asian Diving Championships 2024 (24-27 October 2024) • 2nd Malaysia Open Diving Championships 2024 (01-04 November 2024) • World Aquatics Diving Recognised Events as identified by the Selection Committee (January 2025 - Sport Entries Deadline 2025)
Key Deadlines	Key deadlines will be set upon release of the event information bulletin. Final team to be selected prior to the final Sport Entries Deadline.
Events & Quota	SAQ intends to select the maximum number of qualified athletes allowed as per the information bulletin. <p>Individual Events – maximum of 2 athletes per gender per event</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Eligibility	A diver must meet all the following eligibility criteria and maintain through the competition: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Be a Singapore Citizen.

	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 2. Meet the minimum age requirement; athlete must be fourteen years of age by 31st December 2025. 3. Be a registered member of Singapore Aquatics (SAQ) in good standing. 4. Not used or administered any substance which, if it had been detected as being present in the athlete’s body tissue or fluids, would have constituted doping, or used any prohibited method or committed any other doping offence as defined in ADS, WADA or AQUA’s Anti-Doping By-law. 5. In addition to the qualifying criteria below, the following qualities of the divers will be taken into consideration: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Attitude and behaviour; b. General conduct and past disciplinary record; c. Current skill level and fitness; and character; d. Level of commitment and training attendance at minimum 80%; e. Potential for future development; f. Ability to demonstrate team spirit and work well with teammates and officials 6. Continues to train regularly for peak diving performance and be fit for competition for at least 3 months leading up to the competition.
Qualifying Criteria	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Divers must perform a dive list with a minimum degree of difficulty (DD) AND attain a minimum qualifying score at any of the approved selection events. See Annex A. 2. The minimum DD and qualifying score must be achieved in the same event. 3. For platform events, qualifying score must be achieved with a list completed from 10m platform. 4. Quota spots will be allocated in order of highest score achieved at the selection events. 5. If three or more divers / two or more pairs hit the same qualifying score at the qualifying events, a final trial will be held prior to the Sport Entries Deadline, the top ranked diver/pair from the trial will be selected. 6. In the event that a quota spot has not been fulfilled at the selection events, a final trial may be held to provide opportunity to qualify the remaining quota spots prior to the Sport Entries Deadline. 7. The Selection Committee will select divers for the Team Event from those divers who qualify through individual and/or synchronised events. Selection will be made based on the individual execution scores achieved at the selection events. 8. The Selection Committee will select divers for the Team Event from those divers who qualify through individual and/or synchronised events. Selection will be made to achieve the best team performance whilst considering the individual and synchronised dive requirements for the event.

	<p>9. Any selected diver who declines participation in the competition must inform the Sport Manager (Diving) in writing within 48 hours from the announcement of the selection results.</p> <p>10. The National Head Coach and the Selection Committee reserve the right to make the final decision to determine the final entry by name list.</p>
Team Commitments	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Sign the current SAQ Athlete’s Agreement and comply with the provisions of the Agreement at all times. 2. Conform to SAQ requirements regarding team participation. This includes, but may not be limited to, providing an acceptable training plan, attendance at a pre-event camp and wearing team uniform as required. 3. Make themselves available for all team activities designated by SAQ. 4. The athlete should be a role model and not act in such a manner as to bring the athlete or SAQ into public disrepute. 5. Divers and officials are required to appear at events and platforms whereby their images and presence are needed to achieve SAQ’s objectives of giving back to the Sport and the wider community. These obligations will be further outlined in the SAQ Athlete’s Agreement as per Point 1. 6. SAQ reserves the right to withdraw a diver anytime who does not fulfil the requirements laid out in this document.
Appeal Process	<p>Any diver who is aggrieved with his non-selection may undertake an appeal as follows:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The diver must contact the Vice President (Diving) in writing, within 48 hours from the announcement of the selection results and inform of the intent to appeal. 2. The Vice President may ask the diver to outline the basis of his appeal and will seek a report from the National Head Coach, within 24 hours of receiving written notification from the diver. 3. If the appeal committee is of the opinion that the selection process was not adhered to and the appeal is justified, the committee can overturn the decision of the selection committee. The appeals committee decision is final. <p><i>Note: Protests against the scores given by the judges during the competition or trials conducted, as part of the appeal, shall not be considered.</i></p>
