Policy Objective	To select a team of athletes for nomination to SNOC who will achieve the best possible performance for Team Singapore at SEA Games 2025.
Release Date	18 th October 2024

Selection Events	<p>To be eligible for nomination to SNOC, qualification score must be achieved at one of the following events:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 11th Asian Diving Championships 2024 (24-27 October 2024) • 2nd Malaysia Open Diving Championships 2024 (01-04 November 2024) • 60th Malaysia Invitational Age Group Diving Championships 2025 (Date TBC) • World Aquatics Accredited Events – Various Events 2025 (Dates TBC) • World Aquatics Championships 2025 (26 July – 03 August 2025) • Or any competition sanctioned by AQUA, Asia Aquatics, SEASF or SAQ that falls within the nomination / appeals period, subject to prior approval by SAQ.
SNOC Key Dates	<p>8 March – Entry by Sports deadline 8 April – Entry by Number deadline 15 April – The Longlist phase begins via Sports Sync 15 May – Nomination phase begins via Sports Sync July – Long list and nomination deadline (exact date TBC) August – Selection committee meeting (date TBC) August/September – Appeal committee meeting (date TBC) 19 September – Entry by Name deadline</p>
Team Size	<p>With the approval of SNOC, SAQ intends to send the maximum number of athletes as per the event Rules and Regulations.</p> <p>A list of the events will be confirmed upon release of the event Rules and Regulations.</p>
Eligibility	<p>To be considered for nomination to SNOC, a diver must meet the following eligibility criteria and maintain throughout the Games:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Be a Singapore Citizen and should not be holding dual citizenship if they are above 22 years old. 2. Meet the minimum age requirements as stipulated in the Rules and Regulations. 3. Be a registered member of SAQ in good standing. 4. Signed the current SAQ Athlete Agreement. 5. Continues to train regularly for peak diving performance and be fit for competitions for three months leading up to the Games.

	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 6. Not used or administered any substance which, if it had been detected as being present in the athlete's body tissue or fluids, would have constituted doping, or used any prohibited method or committed any other doping offence as defined in ADS's, WADA or FINA's Anti-Doping By-law. 7. In addition to the qualifying criteria below, the following qualities of the divers will be taken into consideration: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Attitude and behaviour; b. General conduct and past disciplinary record; c. Current skill level and fitness; and character; d. Level of commitment and training attendance at minimum 80%; e. Potential for future development; f. Ability to demonstrate team spirit and work well with teammates and officials.
Qualifying Criteria	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Divers must perform a dive list that achieves the minimum qualifying score at any of the approved selection events. 2. The qualifying scores are based on the performance standards as designated by SNOG which is to have achieved at least 3rd placing score of the 2023 SEA Games. For events which were not featured at the 2023 SEA Games, SAQ will use the 3rd placing score of the most recent SEA Games in which the event was held for nomination by the SAQ Selection Committee. The 3rd placing scores are defined as an 'A' qualifying score in Annex A. 3. The qualifying scores are based on the performance standards as designated by SNOG which is to have achieved at least 3rd placing score of the 2023 SEA Games. For events which were not featured at the 2023 SEA Games, SAQ will use the 3rd placing score of the most recent SEA Games in which the event was held for nomination by the SAQ Selection Committee. The 3rd placing scores are defined as an 'A' qualifying score in Annex A. 4. Where one or no divers qualify under the 'A' qualification score for an individual event, or two or more teams in the platform synchro event, an athlete or synchro team showing potential who attains a minimum 'B' qualifying score (95% of A score), may be considered for nomination by the SAQ Selection Committee. 5. If three or more divers achieve the qualifying score in the individual platform event, or two or more teams in the platform synchro event, a final selection trial will be held prior to the Entry by Name Deadline to select the top ranked divers/team for nomination. 6. If three or more divers achieve the qualifying score in the individual platform event, or two or more teams in the platform synchro event, an athlete or team who achieved the score with a list performed entirely on the 10m platform will take priority for nomination. 7. Exemption from the qualifying criteria will only be granted due to extenuating circumstances resulting in an athlete's inability to compete in and/or attend an event. On request of SAQ, evidence shall be provided of the extenuating circumstances, prior to the exemption being considered. Extenuating circumstances can include but are not limited to: i. Injury or Illness ii. Equipment Failure iii. Travel Delays iv. Bereavement, and v. Such other circumstances as the selectors may consider to be relevant.

	<p>8. If any diver meets the qualifying criteria but chooses not to accept their nomination, written notice must be given to the Team Manager and Vice President (Diving), within 48 hours of announcement of the team.</p>
Team Commitments	<p>All divers must:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Comply with the provisions of SAQ and SNOC Athlete Agreement at all times. 2. Conform to SAQ requirements regarding team participation. This includes, but may not be limited to, providing an acceptable training plan, attendance at a pre-event camp and wearing team uniform as required. 3. Make themselves available for all team activities designated by SAQ. 4. Not act in such a manner as to bring the athlete or SAQ into public disrepute. 5. Divers and Officials are required to appear at events and platforms whereby their images and presence are needed to achieve SNOC's and SAQ's objectives of giving back to the Sport and the wider community. These obligations will be further outlined in the SNOC and SAQ Athletes and Officials Agreement as per Point 1.
Appeal Process	<p>Any diver who is aggrieved with his/her non-selection may undertake an appeal as follows:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The diver must contact the Vice President (Diving) within 48 hours from the official announcement of the selection results and inform of his/her intent to appeal. 2. The Vice President may ask the diver to outline the basis of his/her appeal and will seek a report from the National Head Coach, within 24 hours of receiving written notification from the diver. 3. If the appeal committee is of the opinion that the selection process was not adhered to and the appeal is justified, the committee can overturn the decision of the selection committee. The appeals committee decision is final. <p>Note : - <i>Protests against the scores given by the judges during the competition or trials conducted, as part of the appeal, shall not be considered.</i></p>
Notes	<p>The Singapore National Olympic Council (SNOC) is the body which sets the qualifying standards for all sports.
